

Rosemark At Mayfair Park Hosts Grand Opening Gala

Rosemark at Mayfair Park held its Grand Opening Gala on May 24 at its new location at 833 Jersey Street in Denver. A capacity crowd of invited guests were treated to appetizers, most of which were made by Rosemark's Executive Chef Todd Ostrander, beverages, live music by J.C. Ruckerman, and tours of the facility.

Rosemark at Mayfair Park, which at time of press has been open seven weeks, is an 88-room senior living community featuring 33,000 square feet of living space and outdoor gardens, plus community services including secure walking paths with raised planting beds and patio seating, private dining room with optional catering for family celebrations and intimate gatherings, a home theater, beauty salon and barber-shop, a fitness center, and more.

They have three types of living options that include assisted living, memory support, and respite care. Individual apartments have different floor plans from which to choose. Rosemark integrates important amenities, unobtrusive safety measures, care-giving practices and life-enriching technologies.

This property is part of the Rosemark Development Group. In attendance was Co-Founder and Principal Anne Rosen who oversees design, entitlements, construction and marketing of new projects.

Rosen served as director of real estate for the redevelopment of the former Lowry Air Force Base, now Denver's 1,866-acre Lowry community. Rosen oversaw a real estate team whose efforts resulted in commercial and residential land sales of over \$123 million and \$1.1 billion in development value.

"We bring a fresh perspective to loving and personalized senior care," says Rosen. "We are excited to share our community with Denver. We want Denver to see, feel, touch and taste Rosemark. A lot of thought


